


Prices of nonferrous metals and gold



Global GDP and steel production growth




Average annual % growth over period





China's urban population





Stainless steel per capita intensity of use



China's production of stainless steel



Exploration expenditure, US\$ million





Trends in gold production






Russia's place in world mining
